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Students in grades 11&12 can attend a half day at LCTI as an ACCHS student



Students must have completed:

- Algebra 1&2
- Biology and Chemistry
- Two years of a consecutive world language

In addition to LCTI students would be enrolled in:

- 11th grade- Theology, English, Math
- 12th grade-Theology, English, Government and Economics

Considerations

ACCHS courses must be taken during the half day students are present. This may eliminate some options for scheduled for that time.



Students go to LCTI whenever they are open even if ACCHS is closed.

Students do not have to attend on half days (ex.exams) or when special events take place at ACCHS (ex.40 Hours) ACCHS tuition is prorated at 60% of current tuition.

As with ACCHS courses, students have one letter cycle to withdraw from LCTI (some elective courses may not be available at that time).

Transportation is provided by ACCHS and student return before the end of the school day. Students are not permitted to transport themselves to LCTI unless there is a unique situation. Permission to drive there must be obtained by LCTI
